### Comments

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a Licensing Study. This visit was conducted virtually between the Consultant and the Provider.

An Administrative Review for an Annual Inspection/Licensing Study was submitted by the Provider on June 21, 2022. Consultant completed the Administrative Review on June 23, 2022.

An Exit Conference was conducted with the Provider on June 24, 2022 to discuss the Licensing Study report. Consultant emailed the report to the Provider requesting signature and to be returned to the Consultant within two business days.

Due to the visit being conducted virtually and the Consultant unable to measure resilient surface, Consultant deferred the Playground citation on ,Preschool Playground from the previous visit which was conducted on November 5, 2021.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





### **Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:**

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.
