- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important New Deadlines:

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.

.32(7) - This citation was observed to be corrected on this date. The provider put a Plan of Improvement in place where the staff will conduct a well check for each child during morning arrival for any scratches, bruises or any other types of marks and will address with the parent. Staff will also limit children from moving room to room unless necessary. In addition, staff that do have to move children to another room, will conduct a well check for each child while leaving the child with another staff member or accepting a child from another staff member. Staff will document any major accidents and report them to management to ensure parents are informed immediately. Management will reiterate the importance of supervision of children and documenting any incidents that may happen throughout the day.
