The purpose of this visit was to conduct a Complaint Investigation and Monitoring Visit. This visit was conducted in person by the consultant on July 20, 2022.

An Administrative Review was not needed due to the Provider does not provide transportation, field trips or swimming. Provider has not dispensed medication since the previous visit which occurred on May 5, 2022.

An exit conference discussing the Monitoring visit and complaint investigation report was conducted on July 22, 2022. Consultant emailed both reports to the provider requesting signature and to be returned to the consultant within two business days.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.
