The purpose of this visit was to conduct a Monitoring visit. This visit was conducted in person on April 11, 2022. Due to the Provider not having access to the facilit since October of 2021, the facility has been temporarily closed. The provider reopened on April 5, 2022. At this time, there are no enrolled children in the facility. During the walk through, the consultant discussed with provider to clean and sanitize each classroom and toys, cots, mats, cribs and sheets before children return. Consultant also discussed grass being cut before children return. Due to a six month break in child care services, the Consultant informed the owner that criminal record checks would have to be conducted again, before children are present in the facility.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. - New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.
