Comments

The purpose of this visit was to conduct a Monitoring Visit. This visit was conducted in person by the consultant on July 20, 2022.

Consultant uploaded children's immunization and daily attendance into a required report for the provider. Provider had no new children to enroll since previous visit on February 23, 2022. Administrative Review was completed on July 21, 2022.

An Exit Conference discussing the Monitoring Report was conducted on July 21, 2022. Consultant emailed the Monitoring report to the Provider requesting signature and to be returned to the consultant within two business days.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on Consultant's observation three active ant beds were found on the playground. One small active ant bed was located in front of the play equipment, a second bigger active ant bed was located towards the fence to the right and a third active ant bed was located towards the fence to the left beside the plastic cars.

The Home will repair any and all identified outdoor hazards and will monitor playground daily or more often as needed to ensure that the Home's outdoor play area is kept clean and free of hazards.
