* The resilient surface under the slide on the Left Playground that was 42 inches high, was approximately between half and one inch, when at least three (3) inches of depth were required.

* The resilient surface in the fall zones of the regular swings on the Right Playground measured between half and one inch, when at least six (6) inches were required.

* The resilient surface in the fall zone of the five and a half feet slide on the Right Playground measured approximately one inch, when at least six inches of depth were required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Additional mulch was ordered. The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones where needed and check daily, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.
