It was determined based on observation that the following areas of fencing were in need of repairs; There were rough edges at the bottom on the right side and back, there were five exposed screws by the gate, there were several loose planks with exposed nails, and the gate was observed to be strapped with a bungee cord creating a gap of more than three inches.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Home will enclose the outside play area(s) with a four-foot high fence or other Department-approved barrier and inspect regularly to ensure fencing material is safe and any hazards identified are repaired or replaced. The Home will install or repair a fence around swimming pools that makes them inaccessible to children.
