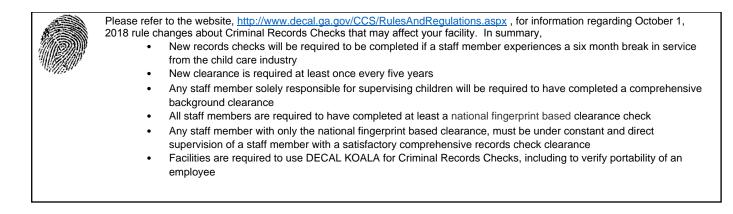

There was no other staff present to cover breaks or any other emergencies. Prior to end of the visit another staff person arrived from another center location to assist with lunch, however, the staff person was not permanent to the facility, and the Director informed that the center had two teachers guit in the last week.

The Center will ensure that an adequate number of qualified employees is available to ensure full compliance with these rules without neglecting the supervision of the children.

A ratio of 2:8 was required, due to three infant children, a two year -old child and four one year -old children being present.
