The staff person did not have documentation on file of a new criminal records check; he had criminal records check dated 2/19/2016. He had documentation that a new child abuse and neglect check had been submitted but the results had not been returned at the time of the inspection. The staff schedule showed that he worked alone from 6:15 AM to 7:00 AM. The staff person in charge stated that children arrive at the program at about 6:45 AM. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470; 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19); 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee. Findings: General: Based on Review of documentation and interview, there were two (2) staff rehired on 3/17/17. Neither staff had documentation of new criminal records checks on file; both had criminal records checks dated 2/19/2016. Both had documentation that new child abuse and neglect checks had been submitted but the results had not been returned at the time of the inspection. The staff schedule showed that one (1) of these staff worked alone from 6:15 AM to 7:00 AM. The staff person in charge stated that children arrive at the program at about 6:45 AM. Therefore, this staff person worked alone with children for about fifteen (15) miniutes.

(14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a staff person hired 12/10/15 did not have documentation of having completed the required pediatric abusive head trauma training, The ECE-Tris database showed no record of the training.
