- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. An electrical outlet located over the sink in the girls restroom was missing one (1) outlet cover.
- 2. An electrical outlet located over the sink in the boys restroom was missing two (2) outlet covers.
- 3. A mop, as well as a bucket containing what appeared to be dirty mop water, in the Younger School-Age Classroom, beside of the boy's restroom door.

Therefore, the health, safety, and comfort of the children were compromised.

- (j) Assess each staff person's interaction with children in care and classroom performance through an annual written performance evaluation;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The personnel files for staff (DOH: 4/2/18, 10/28/19, 3/18/17, 4/1/19) did not contain annual written performance evaluations.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 9/4/12) personnel file contained a written performance evaluation dated for 1/16/19.

During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she thought that the owner had the evaluations at the other center; however, the owner was on vacation and the staff-in-charge could not request those be sent to her while the surveyor was present.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The personnel files for two staff (DOH: 5/20/21 and 4/2/18) did not contain documentation of a negative tuberculin result. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she did not realize that the documents provided by the staff only indicated that the test was administered and did not reflect the test result. She stated that she would instruct the staff to go back and have the test completed and results read.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 9/4/12) negative tuberculin result was no longer current after 2/17/21. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the document is probably at the other center and has not been sent to them yet.
- 3. A staff's (DOH: 10/28/19) negative tuberculin result was no longer current after 8/15/20. Staff-in-charge stated that she did not realize that it was no longer current and would instruct the staff to have it completed.

Therefore, the child-care center failed to show proof that the employees are free of active tuberculosis or provide a copy of a negative tuberculin result.

(1) Screen time, electronic viewing and listening devices shall only be used in the center as a part of the child's planned program of activity as established in Section 2(4) and (5) of this administrative regulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor observed the children in the Preschool Classroom watching a cartoon and the School-Age Classroom watching the Nickelodeon television program "Henry Danger" for approximately forty-five (45) minutes to one (1) hour, the television programs were not part of the children's planned program of activity. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she had been told that once per month the children could watch a movie/television program and that they normally do so around the middle of the month.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found dirt/debris on the rug located in the School-Age Classroom; therefore, the premises was not kept clean.

695 - Toilet

- (4) Each toilet shall:
- (a) Be kept in clean condition;
- (b) Be kept in good repair;
- (c) Be in a lighted room; and
- (d) Have ventilation to outside air.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found a dark ring inside the toilet bowl; therefore the toilet was not kept clean.

- (4) A child shall:
- (a) Be helped with personal care and cleanliness based upon his or her developmental skills;
- (b) Except as established in paragraph (c) of this subsection, wash his or her hands with liquid soap and warm running water:
- 1. a. Upon arrival at the center; or
- b. Within thirty (30) minutes of arrival for school-age children;
- 2. Before and after eating or handling food;
- 3. After toileting or diaper change;
- 4. After handling animals;
- 5. After touching an item or an area of the body soiled with body fluids or wastes; and
- 6. After outdoor or indoor play time: and
- (c) Use hand sanitizer or hand-sanitizing wipes if liquid soap and warm running water are not available in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection. The child shall wash the child's hands as soon as practicable once liquid soap and warm running water are available.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, children from the School-Age Classroom and the Preschool Classroom failed to wash their hands prior to eating lunch. During interview, staff-incharge stated that they simply forgot to have them wash their hands. Therefore, the child-care center failed to ensure that the children washed their hands before eating or handling

- 3. As part of the cooking process; or
- 4. By another method in accordance with the Department for Public Health's food safety standards and permits, established in KRS Chapter 217.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The thermometer located in the chest freezer was broken; therefore, the surveyor was unable to determine if the temperature was kept at a temperature of zero (0) degrees Fahrenheit or below as required.
- 2. The thermometer located in the freezer in the Infant Classroom indicated a temperature of thirty-three (33) degrees Fahrenheit; therefore the temperature was not kept at a temperature of zero (0) degrees Fahrenheit or below as required.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The personnel files for staff (DOH: 4/2/18, 10/28/19, 3/18/17, 4/1/19) did not contain a written annual professional development plan.
- 2. The personnel file for staff (DOH: 9/4/12) contained a professional development plan dated 9/4/2012.

During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she thought that the owner had the professional development plans at the other center; however, the owner was on vacation and staff-incharge was unable to request those be sent to her while the surveyor was present. Therefore, the surveyor was unable to determine if the annual professional development plans were completed as required.
