390 - Educational Requirements **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.
(1) Child-care center staff:
(a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
1. High school diploma;
2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, staff hired on 08/28/19 and 10/25/18, did not have education documentation on file.

395 - TB Verification **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.
(1) Child-care center staff:
(b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 12/08/15 and 08/28/19, did not have documentation on file from a health care professional stating that they were free of active tuberculosis.

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410 - Training

Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.
(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff hired on 08/28/19 had not completed Orientation I and II or the Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma class that is required by the Cabinet. This information was verified through ECE-TRIS.

(21) A protective surface shall:
(a) Be provided for outdoor play equipment used to:
1. Climb;
2. Swing; and
3. Slide; and
(b) Have a fall zone equal to the height of the equipment.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, there was mainly dirt found under the swings and slides on the outdoor playground.

(1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
(a) Kept clean and in good repair; and
(b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.

General: Based on observation, there were two bucket seats in the one-year-old classroom that did not have safety straps.

1025 - Refrigerator

Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 8. Kitchen Requirements.
(4) A cold-storage facility used for storage of perishable food in a nonfrozen state shall:
(a) Have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device;
(b) Be in a safe environment for preservation; and
(c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, there was no thermometer inside the refrigerator in the one-year-old classroom.

1050 - Bottles

Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 8. Kitchen Requirements.
(9) Bottles shall be:
(a) Individually labeled;
(b) Promptly refrigerated;
(c) Covered while not in use; and
(d) Consumed within one (1) hour of being heated or removed from the refrigerator.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, there were two bottles that were not labeled with a child's name in the infant room refrigerator.
