| Findings: General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following: 1. A red tricycle that was missing one (1) pedal located on the playground. 2. What appeared to be a red sand table that was uncovered and contained a small amount of water located next to the fence on the playground. The top to the sand table was observed to be placed on the concrete next to the table. The sand table was observed to be missing two (2) rolling wheels. The rolling wheels were observed to be placed on the concrete near the table. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the red table was a sand table and that the children have not been on the playground due to the weather. | | |
