Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements. (1) An infant shall sleep or nap on the infant's back unless the infant's health professional signs a waiver that states the infant requires an alternate sleeping position. Findings: General: Based on observation, a ten (10) week old child (DOE: 12-19-16) was observed to be sleeping in a bouncy seat for at least twenty (20) minutes. Based on review of documentation, the child's file did not contain a waiver signed by a health professional stating that the child required an alternate sleeping position. In Compliance Premises Not In Compliance **Hygienic Practices** 625 - Diaper Changing Area/Surface Not In Compliance 922 KAR 2:120. Section 10. Toilet, Diapering, and Toiletry Requirements. (10) When a child is diapered, the child shall: (b) Be placed on a surface that is: 1. Clean: 2. Padded; 3. Free of holes, rips, tears, or other damage; 4. Nonabsorbent; 5. Easily cleaned; and 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing. Findings: General: Based on observation of the two-year-old classroom, a staff member used the carpeted floor to change a child's diaper; therefore, the child was not placed on a padded,

General: Based on observation of the two-year-old classroom, a staff member used the carpeted floor to change a child's diaper; therefore, the child was not placed on a padded, nonabsorbent, and easily cleaned surface. Based on interview, the director stated that staff has a padded mat available for them to use during diaper changes; however, the staff do not use the mat on a regular basis.

(3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:

- (a) For an infant:
- An individual non-tiered crib that meets Consumer Product Safety Commission standards established in 16 C.F.R. 1219-1220;
 A firm crib mattress in good repair with a clean tight-fitted sheet that shall be changed:
- a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet;

Findings:

General: Based on observation of the infant classroom, an individual non-tiered crib that meets safety guidelines was not provided for the number of children in attendance on the day of the visit, i.e., on 12-20-16, there were eight (8) infants and four (4) cribs present in the infant classroom. Based on interview, staff stated that more than one (1) child will use the same crib; however, the crib sheets are changed in between uses.
