- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

## Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulations. Review of staff files and ECE-TRIS report revealed the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training was not presented for review at the time of survey for two (2) staff members with the hire dates of 11/21/2016 and 04/10/2013. Interview with the staff in charge revealed the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training for the two (2) aforementioned staff members was unavailable at the time of survey.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to comply with regulations regarding premises. In the preschool bathroom there is a hole in the wall behind the door exposing drywall and insulation.

- (b) Be placed on a surface that is:
  - 1. Clean;
  - 2. Padded;
  - 3. Free of holes, rips, tears, or other damage;
  - 4. Nonabsorbent;
  - 5. Easily cleaned; and
  - 6. Free of any items not used for diaper changing.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with regulations regarding hygienic practices. Observation in the one-year-old room revealed a diaper changing station mounted to the wall that did not contain a padded surface. Further observation of the one-year-old room revealed a staff member with the hire date of 11/10/2017 completed a diaper change with a one-year-old child placed directly on the diaper changing station without a padded surface.

Review of the previous licensure years' statement of deficiencies revealed this was a regulatory violation and the directors plan of correction revealed a changing pad would be placed on top of the mounted diaper changing station before completing a diaper change.

Interview with the staff in charge revealed a diaper changing pad was not available at the time of survey. Further interview, revealed the staff in charge was aware of the previous licensure year statement of deficiencies and plan of corrections.
