#### Findings:

General: Based on interview on a undetermined date in August 2013, multiple children were unsupervised in the three and four year old bathroom in the basement as the remainder of the class went outside. The children were unsupervised for approximately one minute per staff interview before they were retrieved by a staff member and returned to their group.
