General: Based on Observation, a set of keys with a pink and yellow strap were on a small wooden picnic table under a covered patio.

General: Based on Observation, the center had four (4) toilets and eight (8) sinks. The center's capacity was eighty-five (85); therefore, the center did not have enough toilets to meet the capacity.
