A review of the Consumer Product Safety Commission recall information determined the Bumbo seat was recalled in 2007 and instructed consumers to order a free repair kit which included a restraint belt and a warning label.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, three (3) caregivers hired on 8/5/19, 4/1/21, and 1/29/20, had not completed the first aid and CPR training.

690 - Sink

General: Based on review of documentation, two (2) caregivers hired on 6/13/22 and 4/4/22, each had seven and a half (7 1/2) hours of training during the subsequent year of employment. Also, a caregiver hired on 6/21/22, had one and a half (1 ½) hours of training during the subsequent year of employment. Interview determined the caregivers had worked in a Kentucky childcare within five (5) years.

General: Based on observation, the hot water registered at one hundred thirty (130) degrees Fahrenheit at a sink located in the infants' room. The hot water registered at one hundred twenty-three (123) degrees Fahrenheit at a sink located in a restroom in the infants' room, one-year-old's room, and in a restroom in the four and five-year-old's room.
