General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 8/1/16, did not have documentation of education on file.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
 - (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 8/1/16, did not complete six (6) hours of orientation training within the first three (3) months of employment. A caregiver hired on 8/2/14, lacked seven and a half (7.5) hours of training. A caregiver hired on 10/5/14, lacked fifteen (15) hours of training but had college coursework that had not been approved by the cabinet.

General: Based on Observation, the posted daily planned program of activities in the two (2) year olds' room was not being followed and dated 9/12/16 - 9/16/16.
