General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that staff (DOH: 3/7/14) did not have an annual written performance evaluation.

- (I) Provide for the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) The preschool classroom had one (1) electrical outlet with no protective covering.
- (2.) The preschool classroom had one (1) broken electrical outlet with exposted wiring.
- (3.) The toddler classroom had one (1) electrical outlet with no protective covering.
- (4.) The infant room contained a bottle of hand sanitizer on a low shelf that was accessible to the children.

- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that staff's (DOH: 2/1/15) file did not contain a copy of a negative tuberculin result. During interview, the director reported the staff has a negative tuberculin result. A copy of the result could not be provided during the surveyor's visit.

340 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of documentation, and ECE - TRIS, the surveyor found the following:

- (1.) Staff (DOH: 3/7/14) obtained none of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved early care and education training.
- (2.) Staff (DOH: 3/7/14) has not obtained the one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training.
- (3.) Staff (DOH: 2/1/15) obtained six and one-half (6 1/2) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved early care and education training.
- (4.) Staff (DOH: 3/23/16) obtained eight and one-half (8 1/2) of the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved early care and education training.

- (2.) Children's (DOE: 12/12/11) file did not contain a preferred hospital's telephone number.
- (3.) Children's (DOE: 6/10/15) file did not contain a preferred hospital or a preferred physician's telephone number.
- (4.) Children's (DOE: 5/19/15) file did not contain a preferred hospital's telephone number.
