- (f) Assure the development, implementation, and monitoring of child-care center plans, policies, and procedures;
- (g) Supervise staff conduct to ensure implementation of program policies and procedures;

#### Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, a staff member hired on 08/12/19, grabbed a toddler by her left arm and lifted the child from the floor and spun the child around. The child landed in a seated position on the floor. In addition, a staff member hired on 07/29/19, forcefully picked up a toddler to remove from a seated position to be carried out of the room. The center's written policy for staff members stated, "Physical discipline will not be tolerated, including squeezing arms, hands or shoulders; sitting them down hard: picking them up fast or hard; covering a child's mouth with your hand; any type of hitting, slapping, shaking, or jerking. Inappropriate physical touching is grounds for dismissal." The two aforementioned staff members did not follow the center's policy when they picked the children up fast and hard by their arms.
