General: Based on Review of Documentation, one (1) staff hired on 8/9/16 had lived in Texas two (2) years ago and there was not an out-of-state criminal background check on file. The staff member was not working alone during the relicensure survey.

A second staff hired on 8/20/14 had a TB skin test on file that was dated 8/19/14. A third staff hired on 5/6/14 had a TB skin test on file that was dated 5/5/14. A fourth staff hired on 9/22/14 had a TB skin test on file that was dated 9/19/14.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, seven (7) children's records did not contain a phone number to contact the family physician. The name of the child's physician was listed on the enrollment paperwork, but not a phone number.
