General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that employees hired on 8-23-17, 9-19-17, 1-26-18, 1-26-18 and 2-23-18 had not yet completed the six (6) hour cabinetapproved orientation training. Employees hired on 10-25-16, 4-20-17, 8-22-17, 8-23-17 and 9-19-17 had not yet completed Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training. This information was found during a review of the employee files and their ECE-TRIS records.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that there was a broken outlet cover in the eating area for the one-year-old children. The broken edges were sharp and accessible to the children. In the Three Year Old classroom, the linoleum flooring was found to be peeling, exposing the wooden floor beneath. The wall-mounted fan in this classroom was also found to be very dusty. In the Two Year Old classroom, a three (3) inch hole was found to be in the wooden classroom door.
