General: Based on review of documentation, two of the personnel files presented for review did not include a date of employment.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, two employees hired 7/1/19 and 8/14/19, and one employee with no date of employment on file, did not have evidence of a high school diploma, GED or Commonwealth Child Care Credential on file in the facility.

- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:

General: Based on review of documentation, staff persons hired 8/6/17, 8/3/19, 7/1/19 and 8/14/19 did not have documentation of negative T.B. results on file in the facility that had been obtained within the past two years.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1. Four out of five staff employed for more than one year did not have evidence of completing 15 hours of annual early care and education training on file in the facility.
- 2. Staff persons hired 9/17/16 and 8/15/18, did not have documentation of completing the pediatric abusive head trauma training within the past five years.
- 3. Staff person hired 8/15/18, did not have evidence of completing the required orientation training in the first three months of employment.

A review of ECE-TRIS records supports the information found during the survey.
