General: Based on Observation, the temperature in the building on 10/25/17 was sixty-five degrees. The staff person in charge stated that the gas was shut off a couple of days ago because of a new resturant being built next to their facility. She stated that the only gas they use at the facility is for heating the building so not until a couple of days ago was the heat turned on. She stated that everything else at the facility is operated by electric and the gas did not need to be turned on until recently due to the weather getting colder.
