General: Based on review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1.) A staff member hired 6/23/21, did not take the Orientation training within three months of employment. The courses were taken 10/03/21.
- 2.) A staff member hired 6/22/21, did not have evidence of completing 15 hours of annual early care and education training.

A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed these findings.

General: Based on observation, there was an unlocked closet in the Junior Kindergarten room where surveyor found candy, a broom with dust pan, and staff's personal belongings. Those items were accessible to the children in care.
