(d) Provide written proof of liability insurance coverage of at least \$100,000 per occurrence;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the facility's insurance policy limits the facility to twelve (12) children. At the time of the survey, thirteen (13) children were enrolled. On multiple days during the school year, all thirteen (13) children were present.

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (j) Assess each staff person's interaction with children in care and classroom performance through an annual written performance evaluation;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the files for two (2) eligible employees did not contain evidence of an annual evaluation being completed.

265 - Health, Safety, Comfort Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (I) Provide for the health, safety, and comfort of each child;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that in the bathroom in Preschool 2, a toilet brush and plunger were accessible to the children.



275 - Caregiver Alone Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 4. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

- (1) Effective with the adoption of this administrative regulation, a director shall:
- (n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in Section 3(1)(e)6 of this administrative regulation;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that an employee rehired on 8-9-16 was working alone with three (3) one-year-old children for approximately thirty (30) minutes during the survey. The file for this employee did not contain a completed criminal records check or central registry check that met the requirements of the regulation.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file for an employee rehired on 8-9-16 did not contain evidence of submission for or a new completed criminal records check or central registry check. The background checks in the employees file were dated 2013. This employee was observed to be working alone with three (3) one-year-old children for approximately thirty (30) minutes during the survey.

315 - Educational Requirements

- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file for an employee hired on 11-30-16 did not contain evidence of a high school diploma, GED or Commonwealth Childcare Credential.

320 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
 - 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file for an employee hired on 11-30-16 did not contain evidence of a TB skin test or screening being completed. The staff person stated that she would be unable to get a screening until the following day, which does not meet the requirements of the regulation.

340 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the ECE-TRIS record and the file for an employee hired on 9-20-13 contained evidence of zero (0) hours of cabinet-approved training being completed during the last completed training year. The ECE-TRIS records and files for employees hired on 3-1-15, 8-26-15 and 10-31-15 contained evidence of zero (0) hours of cabinet-approved additional training being completed during the first year of employment. In addition, it was found that the ECE-TRIS records and files for employees hired on 3-1-15, 8-26-15 and 10-31-15 did not contain evidence of the cabinet-approved Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma training being completed.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that a pair of hanging bars approximately three (3) and four (4) feet tall were located in the grass. A built-in ground slide was found to have only a mat on the exit platform. Both pieces of equipment require an approved playground surfacing to be present to help prevent injury.

2. Written policy that specifies that the procedures that were taught at the orientation training shall be implemented by each child-care center staff member.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the facility was unable to produce evidence of a policy stating that their staff were required to implement what they learned at the six-hour cabinet-approved orientation training.
