General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The facility's general liability insurance that was on file indicated that the occupancy restrictions for the preschool program is 30 children. The facility's licensed capacity is 35 children. Based on the insurance restrictions that were documented, the facility cannot exceed a capacity of

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff hired on 10/01/19, did not have proof of education on file.



410 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following items were found:

- 1. A substitute staff hired on 8/09/18, did not complete the six-hour cabinet-approved orientation training within the first three months of employment. There was no evidence in the ECE-TRIS system that the staff member completed the orientation training.
- 2. A substitute staff hired on 6/01/17, did not complete the 15 hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during her completed training year. The staff did not have any training hours in the ECE-TRIS system.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. One child's enrollment paperwork contained an immunization record that did not list an expiration date. The child was enrolled on 3/04/19.
