The bags were accessible to the children in care. 3. There was a staff person's purse sitting on the counter near the sink in the Pre-K classroom. The purse was accessible to the children in care.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the following was found: 1. There was a hole in the wall that had been caused by a doorknob in the Gross Motor room. The hole left chipping paint and exposed/flaking drywall. 2. A section of the black baseboard was missing on the wall beneath the thermostats in the Older Twos classroom. 3. The ceiling vents in the bathrooms in the Older Twos classroom and the cafeteria had an accumulation of dust and dirt. 4. There were four (4) screw-size holes in the wall of the bathroom used by the children in the cafeteria.

590 - Toilet

General: Based on Observation, the following was found: 1. There was a cloth bin containing several tubes/bottles of sunscreen in a lower shelving unit in the Young Preschool classroom. The items were not in a locked condition. 2. There were two (2) bottles of children's cough relief and two (2) bottles of infant pain reliever in the infant classroom that were not labeled with a child's name. 3. There was a tube of Desitin and a bottle of children's Motrin that were not labeled with a child's name in the Younger Ones classroom.

General: Based on Observation, the following was found: 1. One of the faucets in the boys' bathroom across from the Older Ones classroom was not functional. 2. All of the black trash cans in all of the classrooms had an accumulation of food/milk spills, dust and dirt.

General: Based on Observation, the following was found: 1. The refrigerator being used to store bottles for the children in the Infant classroom did not contain an indicating thermometer. 2. The refrigerator being used to food/milk for the children in the Younger Ones classroom did not contain an indicating thermometer.

- (9) Bottles shall be:
- (a) Individually labeled;
- (b) Promptly refrigerated;

General: Based on Observation, there were three (3) bottles in the refrigerator in the Infant classroom that were not individually labeled with a child's name.
