## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, three (3) of the blind slats covering the kitchen window were broken and in need of repair. The broken slats were part of the blind covering the window directly adjacent to the kitchen table. These blinds are accessible to children.

- (2) A toilet room shall:
- (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or
- 2. A plan shall be implemented to use the same toilet room at separate times;
- (b) Have a supply of toilet paper; and
- (c) Be cleaned and disinfected daily.

## Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the toilet room was in need of cleaning when inspected by the surveyor. There was a good amount of water on the floor and the toilet had not been flushed from previous use. The water on the floor could be a slip/fall hazard for children using the restroom. The sink and surrounding counter top was also observed to have a large amount of soap residue and water on it which had not been cleaned when inspected.
