> General: Based on observation, it was determined this regulatory requirement was not met. Upon entry to the residence, the surveyor was met by two (2) dogs in the front room. The surveyor entered the kitchen area with the director, which is open to the front room, general classroom area. While the surveyor was speaking with the director, a child stated that one of the dogs had pooped on the floor. Upon inspection, the surveyor did see dog feces on the floor of the general classroom area. The director stated she did not know when the incident could have happened or how long the feces had been on the floor; therefore, the timeframe is unknown. The area was generally accessible to all the children in the home at the time.
