#### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the surveyor entered the playground area of the facility at approximately 9:37 am and observed one staff to be supervising 11 children aged two to six. The staff person in charge was outside of the fenced playground area with two children, while the remaining nine children played inside the fenced playground area. The staff person in charge stated that the second staff person became ill and had to leave, and that she was having someone pick up her own three children in order to correct the ratio issue. This staff person stated that the other staff person had left approximately five minutes before the surveyor arrival. The staff person in charge later entered the facility at 9:55 am and had eight children in her care.
