- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, a staff member hired on 3/19/2019, did not complete the required PAHT training. This staff member has been employed for more than one year. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.

General: Based on observation, it was found that there was a container of Cascade and Finish dishwashing detergent in an unlocked cabinet under the sink in the kitchen, which caused the detergents to be accessible to the children in care. The children eat their meals in the kitchen.
