General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain equipment in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation in the Toddler room revealed a bucket table with six (6) blue buckets, which failed to contain safety belts within the slits from the manufacturer.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

(2) Indoor and outdoor equipment shall:

- (a) Be clean, safe, and in good repair;
- (b) Meet the physical, developmental needs, and interests of children of different age groups;
- (c) Be free from sharp points or corners, splinters, protruding nails or bolts, loose or rusty parts, hazardous small parts, lead-based paint, poisonous material, and flaking or chalking paint; and
- (d) Be designed to guard against entrapment or situations that may cause strangulation.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain equipment in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation in two (2) bathrooms revealed an accumulation of grey dust covering the ceiling ventilation system.
