- 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and
- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, two staff files did not contain the results the background checks. The finger prints were submitted for the staff, but no results were on file in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280. These staff were hired on 10/24/19 and 9/20/19.

400 - CPR/First Aid Coverage

- (3) For a child-care center licensed for infant, toddler, or preschool-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:

- (b) Infant and child first aid.
- (4) For a child-care center licensed for school-age children, at least one (1) person on duty and present with the children shall be currently certified by a cabinet-approved training agency in the following skills:
- (a) Adult cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and
- (b) First aid.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. None of the staff had current CPR and first aid training. The CPR and first aid certificates on file expired on 2/23/2020. The facility operates from 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The ceiling was stained in the kitchennette area next to a blue vent. The stain appeared to be a water stain.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. The white half wall in the 2-3 year-old room contained some areas of chipped paint and tape residue on the surface.
- 2. The Preschool & School-Age Room contained colorful plastic coverings on the ceiling. Some of the plastic coverings (towards the back of the room) were torn and in disrepair.

- (d) If reusable, be:
- 1. Sanitized; and
- 2. Maintained in a sanitary manner; and

- 1. Liquid soap;
- 2. Adhesive bandages;
- 3. Sterile gauze;
- 4. Medical tape;
- 5. Scissors;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The first aid kit contained a flashlight that was not working.

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A gap was observed between the green fence and the metal pole on the playground. The gap was approximately six inches wide and provided an opening for possible entrapment.

- (c) Posted in advance in a conspicuous place;

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A snack menu was not posted. The facility provides snack to the children daily.

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. One child's file contained an immunization certificate that was no longer current. The immunization certificate was dated 11/26/19.


