General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that the staff's (DOH: 3/3/17) file did not contain a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential. Through interview, staff confirmed a copy of their credentials was not obtained for the file.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that two (2) staff (DOH: 5/31/16, 6/6/14) do not have a current copy of negative tuberculin results in their file. Staff reported they both had an appointment on the date of the surveyor's visit to the center to update their tuberculin result.
