General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found that a box fan was located on top of the cubbies in the Preschool Classroom. The fan was in use and was not secured to the shelf in any way to prevent it from falling off and possibly hitting a child. Staff stated that the air conditioning does not adequately cool one (1) side of the room so the fan is used to help circulate the cool air around the room.

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the surveyor found that a staff file (DOH: 2/26/18) did not contain documentation of a High School Diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential as required. The Director stated that she thought she had obtained documentation of education from the staff member.
