(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following: (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program; (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years. (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240. Findings:

General: Based on interview, the surveyor found the that two (2) staff (DOH: 8/28/20 and 3/3/21) did not complete six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training. During interview, staff stated that the training has been completed; however, there has been an issue with getting TRIS updated. Staff stated that they are working with TRIS to get the trainings updated. Documentation was not provided during the surveyor's visit to verify that the two (2) staff had obtained orientation training.

Based on review of documentation in the personnel file of a staff (DOH: 8/28/20), the surveyor was unable to locate verification that the staff had completed fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. Upon reviewing ECE-TRIS for the timeframe of 07/01/20 – 06/30/21, the surveyor learned that the staff had not completed six (6) hours of the fifteen (15) required hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training.

General: Based on observation, during a tour of Bathroom #1, the surveyor found brown specks located inside the toilet bowl of the toilet; therefore, the toilet was not kept clean.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the water to the sink in the Two-Year Old Classroom was turned off at the valve under the sink. Staff stated that staff turn the water off at the valve due to the children turning the faucet on. Staff stated that she would advise staff to leave the valve turned on.
