General: Based on Observation, it was found that during the survey one (1) staff person was left alone with thirty-one (31) children ages five to eleven (5-11) years. The classroom was out of ratio and over group size for approximately two (2) minutes. In addition, during the survey, two (2) staff were observed to be supervising thirty-two (32) children ages five to eleven (5-11)years. The classroom was out of ratio and over group size for approximately one (1) minute.

- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file for an employee hired on 1-31-17 contained evidence of submission for a central registry check, however, the results had reportedly not yet been received. In addition, this employee reported that she lived in California as recently as June 2016. Her file did not contain evidence of submission for or a completed background check from California. This employee reportedly does not work alone with children. She has been employed at the facility for more than ninety (90) days. The file for an employee hired on 7-1-16 contained evidence of a criminal records check being completed, however, the second page of the report was missing, therefore the results could not be reviewed. This employee does not work alone with the children.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the file and ECE-TRIS record for an employee hired on 11-16-15 did not contain evidence of the cabinet approved six-hour orientation training being completed. In addition, the file and ECE-TRIS record for this same employee contained evidence of zero (0) hours of training being completed during the first year of employment.
