General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff hired on 10/30/17 had a child abuse and neglect submitted on 10/26/17 but no results were found in the file. This staff member did take a child to the bathroom alone during the survey. Staff hired on 02/09/18 had a child abuse and neglect check submitted on 02/08/18 but no results were found in the file. This staff person was not present the day of the survey.

General: Based on Observation, there were two (2) staff present in the cafeteria with twenty seven (27) children ranging in age from five to twelve (5-12) years of age on the day of the survey. At 3:18pm one (1) of the staff took a child to the bathroom leaving the other staff person alone with twenty six (26) children. The staff person returned to the cafeteria with the child at 3:25pm.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the director's file was not present the day of the survey. An interview with the site director stated that it was not available for review. The director was not present at the time of the survey.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

General: Based on Review of Documentation, staff hired on 02/09/17 did not have the required fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training on file. Staff hired on 10/30/17 and 10/18/17 did not have the required Orientation I and II on file within ninety (90) days of employment. This informatin was verified through EČE-TRIS.
