(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of ECE-TRIS, the surveyor found that a staff (DOH: 06/01/22) obtained zero (0) hours of the required six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation training; therefore, the training was not completed within the first three (3) months of employment. During interview, staff-in-charge stated that the staff person had not completed the training as of 09/19/22.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found that the toilet seat moved easily and was not tightly secured to the toilet in the last stall in the girls' restroom; therefore, the toilet was not kept in good repair.

During interview, staff-in-charge stated that she was not aware of the stake on the playground. The surveyor observed the staff person to remove the stake from the playground on the day of the surveyor's visit, 09/19/22.
