#### Findings:

General: Based on Observation and interview it was determined that the center failed to maintain minimum staffing requirements. Observation revealed 18 children aged from three to five years old were in the four and five year old classroom being supervised by one staff member, exceeding ratio. Interview with the Director revealed that due to inclement weather and lack of staff, the three year old children were combined with the four and five year old children.
