Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. Observation of the cafeteria revealed seventy-eight (78) children, intermingling as one group, in the care of five (5) staff members. Interview with a staff member revealed the youngest child in care was four-years-old. Therefore, the center exceeded minimum staff-to-child ratios and maximum group size during this time.
