General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain background checks in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff in charge did not provide verification that the KARES report had been accurately maintained to reflect the employees that had separated from employment.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. At 08:10 a.m., there were two (2) staff present with thirty-seven (37) children. Interview with the staff revealed the children ranged in age from five to six years of age. Therefore, the classroom was out of ratio by eight (8) children and exceeding the maximum group size of thirty (30).

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

## Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the record of the employees with the hire dates of 08/28/2013, 08/12/2015, 10/24/2016 and 03/14/2017 had met the requirement of Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment. Review of the ECE-TRIS training system indicated the above-mentioned employees had not met the requirement.
