Findings: General: Based on interview and review of documentation, a caregiver hired 05/17/21, did not have a criminal records check on file. Findings: General: Based on observation and interview, twelve (12) children, aged five-years-old to nine-years-old, did not wear a mask in school-age room #1. In addition, eight (8) children, aged three-years-old to eleven-years-old, did not wear a mask in school-age room #2.

335 - Staff Management/Policy Development/Supervision

922 KAR 2:090. Section 10. Director Requirements and Responsibilities.

(1) A director shall:

(e) Manage the staff in their individual job descriptions;

(f) Assure the development, implementation, and monitoring of child-care center plans, policies, and procedures;

(g) Supervise staff conduct to ensure implementation of program policies and procedures;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the center's policies and procedures on discipline stated unacceptable behavior will be recognize and explanations given to the child. The center will use short periods of inactivity, no more than one minute per year old of the child. The center will notify parents if the child continues the unacceptable behavior. Staff did not follow the center's discipline policy when a three-year-old child, who had unacceptable behavior, was placed in the nursery for thirty (30) minutes to calm down on 05/17/21.

485 - Infant Sleep Position

922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements.

(1) An infant shall sleep or nap on the infant's back unless the infant's health professional signs a waiver that states the infant requires an alternate sleeping position.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, two (2) infants slept in a bouncy seat and an infant slept in a swing for approximately thirty (30) minutes in the infants' room. A signed waiver from a health professional that stated the infant required an alternate sleep position was not on file for each infant.
