# 255 - Notification of Changes

922 KAR 2:090. Section 12. Reports.

(4)(a) Written notification of the following shall be:

- 1. Made to the cabinet, in writing, to allow for approval before implementation:
- a. Change of ownership;
- b. Change of location;
- c. Increase in capacity;
- d. Change in hours of operation;
- e. Change of services in the following categories:
- (i) Infant;
- (ii) Toddler;
- (iii) Preschool-age;
- (iv) School-age;
- (v) Nontraditional hours; or
- (vi) Transportation; or
- f. Addition to or reduction of the square footage of a child-care center's premises;

# Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The provider is not licensed and approved to care for toddlers; however, two-year-old children were present on the day of the survey. Toddlers are defined in the regulations as 12-24 months-old and 24-36 months-old. The youngest child in care during the renewal survey was twenty-four-months-old.

## **Employee Records**

385 - Personnel File Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 9. Records.

- (1) A child-care center shall maintain:
- (e) A current personnel file for each child-care center staff person to include:
- 1. Name, address, date of birth, and date of employment;
- 2. Proof of educational qualifications;
- 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;
- 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and
- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

# Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A staff member hired on 9/01/2020, did not have written evidence on file of the submission of the criminal records check or the CAN check. The staff member was not working alone during the renewal survey.
- 2. Two staff, both hired on 9/01/2020, did not have hire dates documented on their staff files. The staff in charge verbally gave the surveyor the hire dates for the staff.

# 410 - Training Not In Compliance

### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. A staff member hired on 9/01/1980, did not have a current pediatric abusive head trauma training course completed. The pediatric abusive head trauma training on file was dated 5/05/2013. This training shall be completed every five years. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.

## 922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
- (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and
- (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, this regulatory requirement was not met. Room 105, used to care for four-year-old children, contained a brown, staff member's purse on the bottom shelf of an unlocked cabinet in the classroom. The purse was accessible to the children.
