Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:405E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.	
<b>Findings:</b>	
General: The child care center failed to assure compliance with the requirements specific to the current pandemic as established in 922 KAR 2:405e. Per 922 KAR 2:405e, each child shall remain in the same group throughout the day without interacting with another group. Interview with multiple sources revealed the toddler age children are combined with the preschool age children in the afternoons.
