**922 KAR 2:120. Section 2. Child Care Services.**

**(10) A child shall not be subjected to:**

- (a) Corporal physical discipline pursuant to KRS 199.896(18);**
- (b) Loud, profane, threatening, frightening, humiliating, or abusive language; or**
- (c) Discipline that is associated with:**
  - 1. Rest;**
  - 2. Toileting; or**
  - 3. Food.**

**Findings:**

General: Based on review of documentation, and interviews, the child care center failed to maintain regulatory programming requirements. Based on interviews, a staff member was repeatedly heard speaking to children in the Infant room in a yelling, threatening, and frightening voice. Written documentation revealed harsh language including "If you want this damn bottle, come and get it", "Eat now or you won't get it", and "If you want this damn bottle get off your ass and get it", are examples of statements used by a staff member in the Infant room.

**(8) Diapers or clothing shall be:**

- (a) Changed when soiled or wet;**
- (b) Stored in a covered container temporarily; and**
- (c) Washed or disposed of at least once a day.**

**Findings:**

General: Based on interview, and written documentation, the child care center failed to comply with hygienic practices in accordance with regulatory requirements. Interviews revealed diapers were not changed upon need, when soiled or wet. Continued interviews revealed infants were observed to need diaper changing when staff members were relieved/changed. Additional interview revealed an infant was never wearing a dry diaper when picked up from care. Written documentation revealed daily reports were not completed accurately.

<p><b>Findings:</b></p> <p>General: Based on review of documentation, and interview, the child care center failed to post documentation in accordance with regulatory requirements. A review of postings failed to reveal the most recent statement of deficiencies issued to the provider, and plan of corrections submitted by the provider to the cabinet. Interview with staff in charge acknowledged the SOD and POC were not posted at the time of the inspection.</p>
