### Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. A small hole in the ground located between the side fence roll and wooden gazebo on the playground. The hole created a tripping hazard for the children.
- 2. A blue wooden picnic table located under a wooden gazebo on the playground that contained a broken/chipped edge on the end of the seat and was exposing a nail.
- 3. A orange wooden picnic table located under a wooden gazebo on the playground that contained a broken/chipped edge on the end of the seat.
- 4. A metal chain placed on the ground and leading from a red wooden picnic table to a yellow wooden picnic table that were located under a wooden gazebo on the playground. The end of the chain was observed to be chained to each picnic table. The chain created a tripping hazard for the children.
