922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 1/2) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the record of the employees with the hire dates of 10/02/2017 and 07/12/2017 had completed orientation training within the first ninety (90) days of employment. Review of documentation in the ECE-TRIS training system revealed the staff members listed above had not met the requirements.

(ii) Restriction on the child's participation in	activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health	professional; and
(iii) Permission from the parent for third-part	y professional services in the child-care center;	
e. The name and phone number of each perso	n to be contacted in an emergency involving or impacting the child;	
f. Authorization by the parent for the child-ca	re center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent?	s absence;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to maintain children's records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the staff in charge did not present verification that the records for the children with the enrollment dates of 08/16/2017 and 11/07/2017 contained information listing a name of a preferred hospital.
