- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

### Findings

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the following was found:

- ) Staff hired on 08/05/19, did not have documentation from a health care professional stating she was free of active tuberculosis.
- 2) Staff hired on 01/29/19, had a negative TB skin test documentation on file dated 01/31/19, which was after the staff person's hire date. 3) Staff hired on 07/02/19, had a negative TB skin test documentation on file dated 08/25/19, which was after the staff person's hire date. 4) Staff hired on 03/29/17, did not have documentation from a health care professional stating she was free of active tuberculosis.

410 - Training Not In Compliance

### 922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, the following was found:

- 1) Staff hired on 07/25/14, had taken the pediatric abusive head trauma course on 05/05/14, but had not retaken the course, which is required every five years.
- ) Staff hired on 06/20/19, had not taken the Orientation I and II class within the first three months of employment.
- 3) Staff hired on 10/19/17, 01/09/17, and 05/18/15, did not have the required 15 hours of cabinet approved training on file.
